NEW BUSINESS



Proposed By-Law Changes

Article III: Membership, Section 5.

5. Absences. A Member automatically loses his/her status as a voting Member if absent three (3) consecutive meetings without representation by a person holding a valid proxy for that Member. Voting Membership may be restored without additional membership application or payment of dues by a majority vote of the SCRC Members present at the regular business meeting in which the vote is called. For this section, a meeting shall include all properly called meetings of the SCRC at which roll is called, whether or not a quorum is present. Effective 1 January 2027, a member of the SCRC is deemed to have resigned if that member fails to attend "in person" at least fifty (50) percent of the regular meetings in any calendar year*. A medical reason, documented in writing by a Doctor, Physician's Assistant, or Registered Nurse and presented to the Committee Secretary, will be considered an acceptable reason for missing a meeting.

Article III: Membership

5. Membership List. Any Member in good standing may request, and the Secretary shall provide, a copy of the list of all Members maintained by the Secretary, to include relevant contact information. Members must treat this list as confidential and shall pledge to not disclose such list to any non-Member. Notwithstanding the foregoing, The Chairman may, if requested, provide the Membership List to members of the SCRC Executive Committee, Republican candidates and to the Seventh Congressional District Committee or to the Republican Party of Virginia.

*In person is defined as having a physical presence at the meeting. Attendance by proxy does NOT count towards the number of meetings attended to satisfy this requirement.
