Article III: Membership, Section 5.

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Amendment August 10, 2026:

Section 5. Absences.

Under Article III: Membership

Strike the following:

A Member automatically loses his/her status as a voting Member if absent three (3) consecutive meetings without representation by a person holding a valid proxy for that Member. Membership may be restored without additional membership application or payment of dues by a majority vote of the SCRC Members present at the regular business meeting in which the vote is called. For this section, a meeting shall include all properly called meetings of the SCRC at which roll is called, whether or not a quorum is present.

Insert the following:

- (a) A Member automatically loses his/her status as a voting Member if absent three (3) consecutive meetings without representation by a person holding a valid proxy for that Member.
- (b) A Member automatically loses his/her status as a voting Member if absent three (3) consecutive meetings without appearing in person, even if represented by proxy during that time.
- (c) Members losing status as a voting Member per this section will be transferred to Associate Member status.
- (d) Membership may be restored without additional membership application or payment of dues by a majority vote of the SCRC Members present at the regular business meeting in which the vote is called.
- (e) For this section, a meeting shall include all properly called meetings of the SCRC at which roll is called, whether or not a quorum is present.

5. Membership List. ~~Any Member in good standing may request, and the Secretary shall provide, a copy of the list of all Members maintained by the Secretary, to include relevant contact information. Members must treat this list as confidential and shall pledge to not disclose such list to any non--Member. Notwithstanding the foregoing,~~ The Chairman may, if requested, provide the Membership List to members of the SCRC Executive Committee, Republican candidates and to the Seventh Congressional District Committee or to the Republican Party of Virginia.
